RESOLUTION 32, 2024

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PALM BEACH GARDENS, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND RATIFYING A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE POLICE BENEVOLENT ASSOCIATION TO AMEND THE CURRENT COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT AT ARTICLE 32, SALARIES, WITH REGARD TO ALL CITY POLICE OFFICERS, SERGEANTS, AND COMMUNICATIONS OPERATORS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, it has been City policy to make salary adjustments necessary to maintain an externally competitive position of being within the top three (3) to five (5) comparable Palm Beach County law enforcement agencies; however, the local law enforcement labor market has changed dramatically; and

WHEREAS, the City has made a determination that offering the bargaining unit employees a special compensation package, beyond what is provided for in the current Collective Bargaining Agreement, will ensure that the Palm Beach Gardens Police Department remains highly competitive with other agencies; and

WHEREAS, the Police Benevolent Association (PBA) has agreed to amend the Salaries Article of the current Collective Bargaining Agreement to provide the subject salary adjustments for the benefit of the bargaining unit employees; and

WHEREAS, the PBA has ratified and adopted a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) amending the current Collective Bargaining Agreement at Article 32, Salaries, and such MOU is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, given the exigent circumstances, staff is confident that this proactive measure will further enhance the City's ability to provide for the safety and security of our community while demonstrating the City's continued commitment to providing competitive compensation for our employees; and

WHEREAS, the City Council deems approval of this Resolution to be in the best interests of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents and citizens of the City of Palm Beach Gardens and the public at large.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PALM BEACH GARDENS, FLORIDA, that:

SECTION 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> The City Council hereby ratifies, confirms, and approves the MOU amending the current Collective Bargaining Agreement at Article 32, Salaries, and authorizes the City Manager to execute the MOU on behalf of the City.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE CITY OF PALM BEACH GARDENS AND THE POLICE BENEVOLENT ASSOCIATION WITH REGARD TO ALL POLICE OFFICERS, SERGEANTS, AND COMMUNICATIONS OPERATORS EMPLOYED BY THE CITY'S POLICE DEPARTMENT

The City of Palm Beach Gardens ("City") and the Palm Beach County Police Benevolent Association, Inc. ("PBA") agree to amend the current Collective Bargaining Agreement, Article 32, Salaries, as indicated below:

<u>Section 3:</u> The salary ranges effective the first full pay period following ratification of this Article, for each bargaining unit position will be as follows:

Position	Minimum	Maximum	
Police Officer	\$ 70,000	\$118,800	
Police Sergeant	\$109,000	\$134,000	
Communications Operator	\$ 56,120	\$ 86,600	
Communications Supervisor	\$ 63,800	\$101,300	

<u>Section 4:</u> Effective starting the first full pay period following ratification of this Article, all Officers and Sergeants will receive a 15% increase to their base salaries.

Effective starting the first full pay period following ratification of this Article, all Communications Operators and Supervisors will receive a 7% increase to their base salaries.

<u>Section 5:</u> If an employee receives a wage increase which results in his/her base salary exceeding the maximum of the salary range for the position, then the employee will receive a lump sum payment of the amount that exceeds the maximum of the salary range for the position. Said lump sum payment shall not be added to the employee's base salary.

This Memorandum of Understanding shall be effective upon full ratification of the Parties, through and including September 30, 2025.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE CITY OF PALM BEACH GARDENS AND THE POLICE BENEVOLENT ASSOCIATION WITH REGARD TO ALL POLICE OFFICERS, SERGEANTS, AND COMMUNICATIONS OPERATORS EMPLOYED BY THE CITY'S POLICE DEPARTMENT

The City of Palm Beach Gardens ("City") and the Palm Beach County Police Benevolent Association, Inc. ("PBA") agree to amend the current Collective Bargaining Agreement, Article 32, Salaries, as indicated below:

<u>Section 3:</u> The salary ranges effective the first full pay period following ratification of this Article, October 1, 2024 for each bargaining unit position will be as follows:

Police Sergeant	\$ 101,846 109,000	\$134,000		
Communications Operator	\$ 56,120	\$ 86,600		
Communications Supervisor	\$ 63,800	\$101,300		

Section 4: Effective starting the first full pay period beginning on or after October 1, 2022, or on the date of following ratification of this Article, whichever occurs later, all Officers and Sergeants will receive a 15% increase to their base salaries. have their base salaries increased as a result of being placed in the new salary plan, receiving an adjustment to match that indicated in the attached Wage Schedule for FY 2022 2023 which is incorporated into this Agreement as if restated herein. Effective starting the first full pay period beginning on or after October 1, 2022, or on the date of ratification, whichever occurs later, all Communications Operators and Communications Supervisors will receive a 8% increase to their base salaries.

Effective starting the first full pay period beginning on or after October 1, 2023, all bargaining unit members will receive a 7% increase to base salaries. Effective starting the first full pay period following ratification of this Article, beginning on or after October 1, 2024, all Communications Operators and Supervisors bargaining unit members will receive a 7% increase to their base salaries.

<u>Section 5:</u> If an employee receives a wage increase which results in his/her base salary exceeding the maximum of the salary range for the position, then the employee will receive a lump sum payment of the amount that exceeds the maximum of the salary range for the position. Said lump sum payment shall not be added to the employee's base salary.
